Launched in 2007, the Australian Remediation Industry Cluster (ARIC) represents a unique network of Australian expertise in environmental remediation. ARIC was formed to foster the development of new skills and technology to combat contamination. It plays a significant scientific, technical and advisory role in a rapidly expanding the national and international clean-up market.

ARIC provides a platform for organisations to develop a common position on contamination issues that are economically, socially and environmentally challenging. ARIC also liaises with government, advocates policies, action and solutions on contamination issues, and builds relationships with national and international researchers in the assessment, remediation and prevention of contamination.

Outputs include training and professional development, and an industry e-magazine for members that shares the latest findings and technologies, as well as best practice, in environmental remediation.
